1. Introduction

- **a.** All tickets sold by St George's Students' Union for the Summer Ball 2024 are sold in accordance with these terms and conditions.
 - i. Please read the terms and conditions carefully before purchasing any tickets. Purchasing or possession of a ticket constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions.
- **b.** The Summer Ball will be taking place on Friday 28th June 2024

2. Tickets

- **a.** St George's University students and staff can purchase up to 4 tickets. This will be 1 ticket for themselves and up to 3 guests via the St George's Students' Union website.
- **b.** The alumni cohort of the 2022/23 year are also eligible to buy up to 4 tickets, via the St George's Students' Union website.
- c. Students from other institutions, previous alumni, and non-students are not able to purchase tickets from the St George's Students' Union website, but are permitted to attend the event as a guest of a current student, last years' alumni or staff.
- d. 2nd Instalments are due W/C 27th May and must be paid by 5pm on Friday 31st May. Anyone who does not make their second payment will NOT be eligible for a refund and will NOT receive a ticket.
- **e.** All tickets purchased must be exchanged for physical wristbands. More information on this will be released closer to the date of the event.
- f. It is your responsibility to collect both yours and your guests' wristbands.
 - i. You will not be able to collect wristbands on behalf of other students.
 - **ii.** Upon collection of the wristbands, you will be required to confirm the names of your guests as per the post-booking form, so that they can be added to the guest list and permitted entry on the day of the event.
- g. St George's Students' Union will not replace lost or stolen wristbands, so keep them safe.
- **h.** Tickets and wristbands may be invalidated if defaced or damaged.
- i. TICKETS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
- j. ANY MUTUAL TICKET SWAPS MUST BE APPROVED BY ST GEORGE'S STUDENTS' UNION AND CANNOT BE SOLD FOR ABOVE FACE VALUE

3. Age Policy

- a. St George's Students' Union and Wimbledon RFC will be operating a challenge 25 policy. This event is strictly for over 18's only.
- b. Anyone attending the event will be required to show proof of age and all students/staff will be required to show their current St George's University ID Pass. (Alumni will be pre-checked before the event date).
 - i. Acceptable proof of age can consist of: a valid passport; driving license (provisional of full) or PASS approved photo ID. These must be actual documents and pictures or out of date ID will not be accepted.

- c. If you are found to be using identification that does not belong to you, the identification and your wristband will be confiscated, and you will be refused entry to the event.
 - i. As a result of this, your guests will also be refused entry to the event.

4. Entry

- a. By entering the event you are giving your consent to be photographed/filmed or sound recorded as part of the audience.
 - i. If you do not consent to being photographed or recorded, please contact a member of the Summer Ball team on sgsb@su.sgul.ac.uk.
- b. There shall be no re-entry to the event once you have entered.
- c. Management, senior SU executive and security teams reserve the right to refuse entry to attendees.
- d. The following items are not permitted on the site and searches will be a condition of entry. Refusal to cooperate with searches may result in refusal of entry to the event. This list is not exhaustive, and the event management team retain the right to update it at any time.
 - i. No alcohol
 - ii. No liquids (except **ONE** 500ML sealed bottle of water.)
 - iii. No drugs
 - iv. No knives or weapons
 - v. No aerosols or pressurised containers
 - vi. No bikes or scooters
 - vii. No glass bottles
 - viii. No food
 - ix. No flares or fireworks
 - x. No hi-visibility vests
 - xi. No rucksacks or large bags
- e. Any items taken during searches will not be returned to the owner, so be mindful with what you are bringing.
- f. Anyone who presents at the main gates clearly under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be refused entry; will have their wristband confiscated and will **NOT** be eligible for a refund.
- g. St George's Students' Union operates a **ZERO TOLERANCE** policy at all events. Harassment; anti-social; aggressive or violent behaviour of any type will not be tolerated, and you will be removed from the event site. This applies to all people on site including but not limited to; event attendees; SU staff, external contractors; vendors; artists.
